



St. Croix Educational Complex High School Mathematics/Science MAGNET PROGRAM ENTRY TESTING

Admission Policies:

Step 1: To be admitted to the program, a student must:

- A. Be an eighth grade student currently enrolled in honors Math, Science and English classes.
- B. Have an average of 90% or higher in Math, Science and English classes *if not enrolled in honors classes*.
- C. Turn in **completed** application package by March 30th to the registrar's office.
- D. Successfully pass the entrance exam.
- E. Be interested in pursuing a Math or Science-related career.

Step 2: Print a Copy of the Candidate Application Package:

- A. Download *Adobe Reader* if you don't already have it on your computer.
 - B. Click on Prospective Students. Scroll down, click on Magnet Program. Find "Magnet Application".
 - C. Print a copy of the application package. Make sure you print the *Application for Admission* (1 copy), *Teacher Recommendation Form* (3 copies), and *Entry Testing Information* (1 copy).
- * Application can also be picked up from the school's main office.*

Step 3: Complete Candidate Application Package:

- A. Complete the Application form.
- B. Include 3 Recommendation Forms, one each completed by your current Math, Science, and English teachers.
- C. Include current first semester (Marking Periods 1 & 2) report card.

Step 4: Submit Completed Packages by deadline date:

- A. **Public School Students:** To your counselor by March 29th.
- B. **Private School Students:** To Registrar's Office, St. Croix Educational Complex High School by March 30th.

Magnet Entry Test for students who have completed all 4 steps: April 19th, at 8:30 a.m. in St. Croix Educational Complex's Auditorium.
